

# **Vendor Rules of the 30th Annual Caladium Arts & Crafts Festival**

**July 23, 24 & 25, 2021**

*(Retain this copy for your information)*

- The chairperson of the Arts and Crafts exhibits is Joyce Desmet. In the event that there are any questions, disputes, concerns, etc. about exhibiting, she is the person to contact (863) 633-9522 (cell). She is considered the sole arbiter of such situations.

- Only original/hand-crafted work is permitted – created by person renting booth.

- No mass produced, commercial, used, or resale products are allowed. Please note that this does not include creations made from manufactured products (Ex: Floral arrangements, etc.). Violation of this rule will result in you being asked to leave our festival.

- Failure to be present at booth location by 8:00 a.m. on the first day (Friday) of the Festival shall result in the location being assigned to the next applicant on the standby list unless prior notification is made to Joyce Desmet.

- Booth set-up times are as follows:

**Thursday:** After the streets are barricaded at approximately 6:00 p.m.

**Friday:** By 8:30 a.m. After 8:30 a.m., absolutely NO crafter vehicles will be allowed in the exhibit area.

- All vehicles must be out of the show areas by 8:30 a.m. Friday & Saturday; 9:30 on Sunday.

- The hours of the Festival are 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on Friday & Saturday and 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on Sunday. All exhibits shall be ready at least ½ hour before the Festival starts and must remain open until closing time. Early tear downs are not permitted and may result in a vendor's rejection as an exhibitor in future years of this event.

- Booths may remain in place overnight. Vendors are responsible for securing their tents and merchandise. We are not responsible for storm/wind damage. The Lake Placid Police Department patrols the Festival area.

- Each exhibitor shall individually comply with all pertinent State of Florida sales tax requirements for any and all sales made at the Festival.

- The Caladium Arts & Crafts Festival is a family-oriented event. The Festival Committee reserves the right to require the removal of any objectionable work.

- "Exceptions to the Rules" must be approved by the Festival Committee.

Water will be available, however due to the heat we encourage all vendors to bring coolers and their own supplies of water.
